HE Dublin Airport

How to get to and from Dublin Airport

Dublin Airport is located approximately 10km north of Dublin City Centre, which is accessible by bus, taxi, car, cycling or walking.

There are several transport options for those travelling to Dublin City Centre and beyond. You can travel direct to central locations such as O'Connell Street or connect to the rest of Ireland, by reaching Connolly and Heuston train stations, as well as Ireland's central bus station, Bus Áras.

Bus

Dublin Airport is accessible by over 1,000 buses and coaches daily, reaching many areas in and around Dublin and towns and cities across Ireland. Find a route that will take you directly to or from the airport you can now also buy bus tickets to your destination.

HE Shannon Airport

Bus Éireann run the highest frequency direct services to & from Shannon Airport. All services on the Galway/Limerick/Cork corridor pass through the Airport. In addition Bus Éireann provides frequent direct coach services between Shannon Airport & Limerick City; between Shannon Airport & Ennis.

Trains. Although there is no train service that runs directly to the airport terminal, there is a rail service operated by Iarnrod Eirann that runs to Limerick Railway Station, from where a regular bus connection runs to and from the airport.

Car

Ireland West Airport is conveniently located on the main N17 North – South road, halfway between Galway and Sligo. Driving in Ireland is on the left hand side, and speed limits vary. All distances and speed limits use the Metric system (kilometres). If you are setting down passengers at the airport, there is a designated set-down area outside the terminal entrance. Waiting here is not permitted. If you are meeting someone from a flight we advise you to park in the car park, as waiting as the set-down area is not permitted.

By Bus

By train

The nearest railway station to Ireland West Airport is Claremorris (31km) or Ballyhaunis (22km), both on the Dublin Heuston – Westport line. These stations can be accessed by airport cabs or bus services.

Airport Cabs

Ireland West Airport is serviced by a comprehensive fleet of Airport Cabs. Specific airport cabs are vetted and licensed by Ireland West Airport and are available directly outside the arrivals area.

Pre-booking is advisable to ensure a swift transfer to your destination. These cabs provide services to/from the Airport to destinations within the region, complementing bus, rail and car hire transportation.

Farranfore Airport (Kerry Airport)

By Car

Kerry Airport has excellent road connections with the south and west of Ireland on the N23 route. The Airport is located between the towns of Killarney and Tralee and is about one and a half hours driving time from the cities of Cork and Limerick. Kerry Airport provides direct access to the national road network enabling airport users to undertake their journeys without delay on to Wild Atlantic Kerry. Driving in Ireland is on the left hand side.

By Bus

Outside the main terminal is a Bus Terminus with bus services available directly from Kerry Airport to Tralee, Killarney and Limerick linking into the Bus Eireann network. Tickets for all bus services may be purchased onboard the bus.

By Airport Taxi
